#### NET AVAILABLE FUNDS

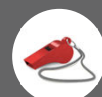
Income remaining after expenses.

#### ATHLETIC PROGRAM DISTRIBUTION

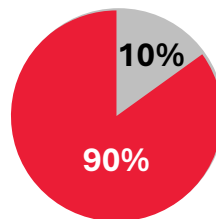
Funds allocated to support our athletic programs.

## COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT IDEAS

Ideas athletic teams can plan and advertise to bring people together, boost attendance, encourage participation and create lasting memories.

<b>CHARITABLE TIE-INS:</b>	Support a cause and promote donation of ½ the entry fees, merchandise sales and audience participation games to charity.
<b>GIVEAWAYS:</b>	Sponsor giveaway such as popcorn, pom-poms or cotton candy to all children under 12 or the first 100 attendees, etc.
<b>FAN ZONE:</b>	Half time games for youth participation (basketball toss, chuck-a-duck, etc); or, Set up an area with games, face painting or temporary tattoos.
<b>PARTNERSHIP:</b>	Invite a local food truck or small business to set up, they may donate a portion of proceeds to the team.
<b>INTERACTIVE GIVEAWAYS:</b>	T-shirt or hot dog tosses make being an attendee fun & engaging.
<b>FEED THEM:</b>	Host a pre-event tailgate or a corn roast, chili or soup stand.
<b>MEET THE MAKERS EVENT:</b>	Varsity and JV players can take pictures and give autographs with young fans. This could be after a game or a separate event kicking off the season. T-shirts, Trading Cards, Posters and Balls have been used as signing items.
<b>ONE OF THE TEAM EVENT:</b>	Invite a Youth team to Attend a game as special guests. At coaches discretion, youth could stand along the out of bounds lines during pregame warmups, line up and slap hands as the starters are announced, come with the Half time Huddle and sit behind the bench.
<b>OUTREACH:</b>	Varsity student athletes read at Elementary classes. HS students could supply a voucher for free entry to an upcoming game and a schedule of the remaining games for the season.
<b>GRATITUDE:</b>	Teacher, military, healthcare or other community group appreciation – athletes invite the person/group to attend with special seating & are announced/thanked.
